

FAQs for Grape Stomp 2018

Seasonal Grape Stomp / \$40 includes stomping, t-shirt, branded Go-Vino and a tasting of three wines

If you really want to get a feel for Wine Country, we invite you to kick off your shoes and stomp grapes, just like Mike Grgich did when he was growing up in Croatia! Enjoy grape stomp and Grgich Hills wine, you'll take home a souvenir t-shirt with your footprints! We offer this harvest experience from August 24th to October 28th, 10:00am to 3:30pm daily. Reservations not accepted for groups smaller than 8. Children are welcome to stomp for a fee of \$20.

How long does it run?

Starts 08/24/18 and continues until we run out of grapes (we are predicting 2 months- if people are coming at the end of October they should call when their visit is closer.)

How much does it cost?

- \$40/person: Stomp & logo'd Go-Vino with a tasting of Chardonnay, Zinfandel and Cabernet
- \$20/person for children
- \$30/Club Member
- 8+ guests: please call to book 10 AM / 11 AM / 12 PM for \$40/person The experience will include Grape Stomp. For an additional \$35 they can add Grgich at a Glance.

Can my child stomp?

Yes, minors are welcome! (\$20 per minor)

Can I make a reservation?

For groups smaller than 8 there are no reservations taken: it's first come, first served.

When is it offered?

Daily. Stomping begins at 10:00am and ends at 3:30pm

How long will I have to wait?

Unfortunately, we cannot provide an estimated wait time – however, it's usually less busy in the morning

How long does it take?

The stomping experience can take anywhere from 5-10 minutes from beginning to end, depending on how long people want to stomp

What other wineries offer this?

We are the only winery in Napa that offers this daily.

What should I wear?

We recommend comfortable clothing – and if you will be wearing pants, we recommend ones that can be rolled up

Will it stain my feet?

No – you're not in the juice long enough to permanently or even temporarily stain your feet. We provide water and towels to clean your feet upon completion.

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Do you use the grapes we're stomping to make wine?

No – the stomped grapes and juice go back in our vineyard.

What wines are included in the experience?

We offer a tasting of Chardonnay, Zinfandel and Cabernet.
