Similar to the "private reserve" style we produced ten years ago in 1982, the 1992 Chardonnay has a wealth of everything you'd expect from a great wine. An enticing aroma leads to a mouthful of densely concentrated fruit mingled with toasty oak flavors derived from new French Limousin barrels. Being a particularly full-bodied wine, it has a sensuous feeling of viscosity in the mouth with a long, lingering finish.

Smooth and drinkable now with lush flavors of ripe pears and Golden Delicious apples, it also has the basic underlying structure and acidity typical of Grgich Hills Chardonnays. We predict that it will age with the very best of our Chardonnays from past vintages.
