## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

1987

*D*elicate but complex, this Cabernet has an aroma of cedar and violets, is medium to full-bodied and has clean, herbal, berry-fruit flavors. The soft tannins help to define the wine's structure without being too harsh or obtrusive. The blend is composed of 7% Merlot for additional smoothness and 10% Cabernet Franc for an extra layer of fruitiness. It was then aged in a combination of French and American oak barrels for two years.

Due to the high quality, but short crop, demand will undoubtedly surpass our supply.
