

his 1992 Cabernet is a dark, brooding wine that is jam-packed with youthful intensity. There are layers of ripe cherry and berry flavors along with an intense aroma of fruit co-mingled with oak. It is a remarkably well-balanced wine for its age and is destined to improve as it gently ages in the cellar for an additional two to five years.

For further complexity, this Cabernet was blended with 4% Merlot for smoothness and 9% Cabernet Franc for fruitiness. After two years of oak aging, we then allowed this wine to undergo a year of bottle aging to marry and balance the flavors. Put some of this wine away, and your patience will be rewarded.
