
## YOUNTVILLE SELECTION ... 100% VARIETAL ... 100% DESIRABLE

## 1994...CABERNET SAUVIGNON...YOUNTVILLE SELECTION

This 1994 *Yountville Selection* Cabernet Sauvignon is a big, dark, highlyextracted, powerful, yet elegant wine that will impress and intrigue you with layer upon layer of complex flavors that are seamlessly woven together. Like our 1991, this wine is 100% varietal, composed only of Cabernet grapes taken from our estate vineyard in Yountville. The initial aroma is one of sweet ripe fruit and newly hewn oak. The taste that follows is very similar with ripe fruit flavors of plum, blackberry and cherry, and soft, mouth-coating tannins that lend plenty of structure to this bold, young wine. Put this one away for another five to ten years. Only 1,050 cases were produced.
