



It isn't possible to produce a dessert wine like our popular *Violetta, Late Harvest* every year, but in 1995 we were once again blessed with just the right conditions in the vineyard to make a second bottling. The 1995 is a bit more intense than the 1994 with a deeper golden color. The aroma exhibits a subtle hint of orange blossoms mingled with ripe peach and apricot and an unmistakable kiss of botrytis. The flavors are equally intense and may remind you of a big spoonful of orange marmalade or apricot jam. Good acidity assures that you will find the wine balanced and harmonious without being syrupy or cloying. Try a glass of *Violetta* with a slice of rich *pâté de foies gras* or serve it for dessert all by itself. (available in 375 ml. bottles only)
