VINTAGE: The 2018 vintage was a bountiful vintage marked by cool, consistent temperatures and a timely rainfall for bud break in March and April. Harvest began on September tenth, and the grapes were of the highest quality with lower alcohol and high acidity.

VINEYARD: The grapes for this wine were grown at Miljenko's Vineyard, a 34-acre parcel of land north of Calistoga overlooked by Miljenko "Mike" Grgich's home. This sunny and well-drained hillside is the perfect site to grow intensely flavored Petite Sirah. We farm all of our certified organic vineyards naturally, using the principles of regenerative agriculture.

THE WINE: This elegant, outstanding Petite Sirah opens with aromas of rich cassis, blackberry and cherry jam followed by notes of candied orange, rosemary, and bay leaf. On the palate one tastes layers of dense, brambly cassis and blackberry, supported by salted toffee with hints of vanilla. The extremely long finish is one of immense richness of fruit with hints of black pepper, clove, and cocoa.
